PURPOSES

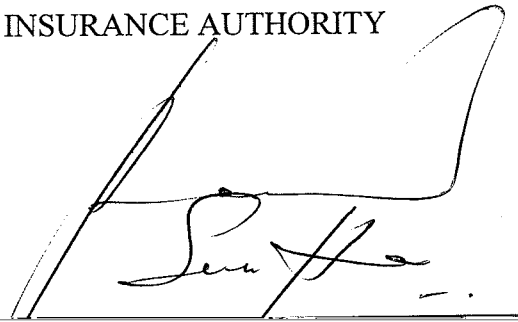

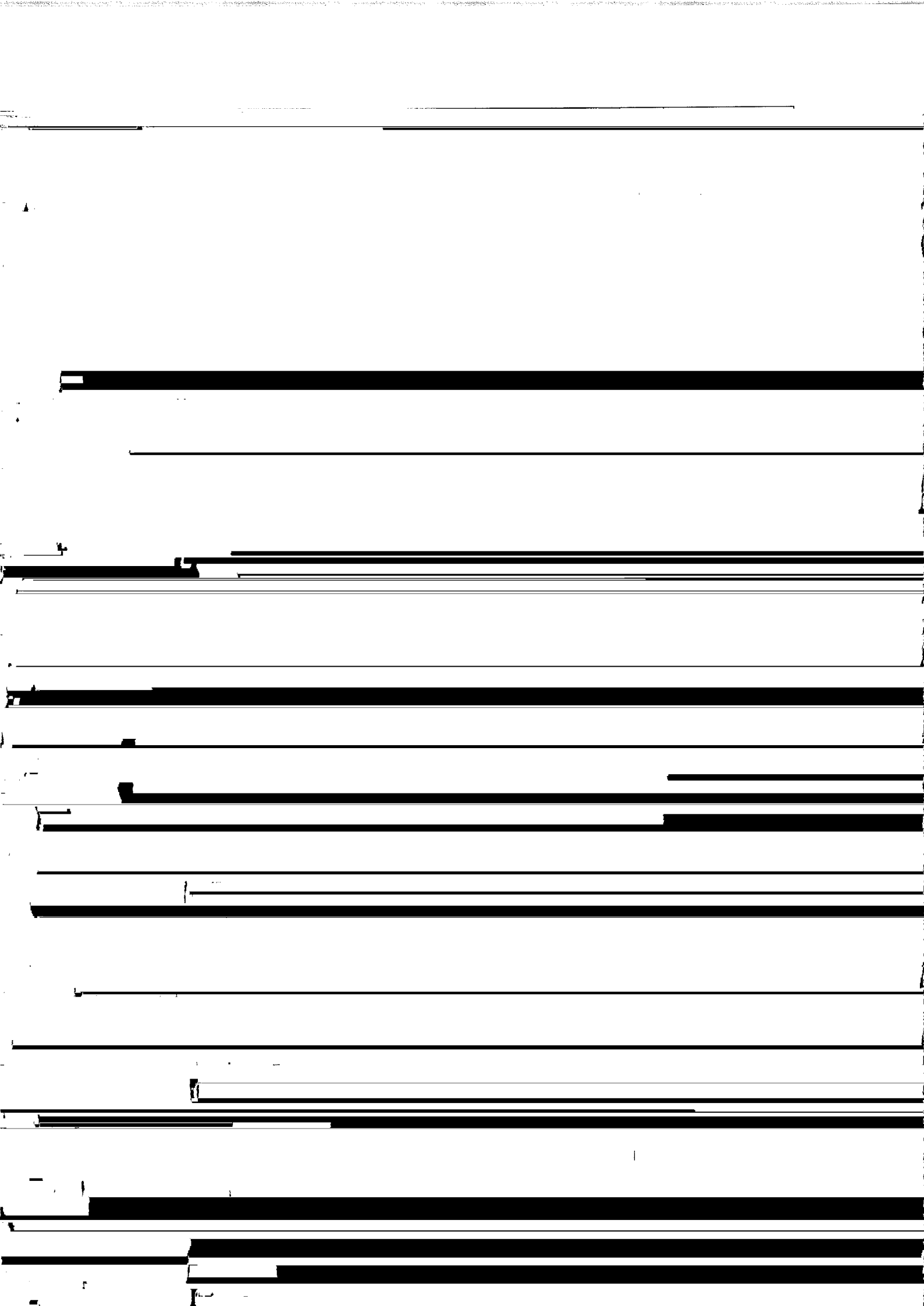
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This MoU shall take effect from 30 April 2014.
